You may already be aware that a Laxfield COVID-19 Community Support Group, made up of volunteers from the village of Laxfield, has been set up to offer help during the COVID-19 pandemic. We would like to remind you of the various ways we may be able to help.

Firstly, the group has a team of volunteers who can offer assistance with such things as shopping and picking up prescriptions for people who are in self-isolation and are 'vulnerable' due to underlying health conditions or because someone in the household is displaying symptoms of COVID-19,

Secondly, the group is offering a telephone chat service and volunteers are standing by to call anyone you feel may appreciate a call; simply provide a phone number to the group and they will do the rest.

Thirdly, the group has access to some funds to help anyone resident in the parish of Laxfield who needs financial help with essential purchases.
